Itinerary

Day 1, SAN JOSE

Arrive in San José. Private Transfer to Hotel. Hotel Finca Rosa Blanca. Cafetal room. (B).
Welcome to Costa Rica. Meet and greet at Juan Santamaria International Airport by our local representative, who will provide you with your welcome kit and transfer you to your hotel.

Day 2, SAN JOSE

Free day at San José. Finca Rosa Blanca (B)

Day 3, SAN JOSE – ARENAL

Transfer to Arenal (3.2 hours). Arenal Nayara Hotel. Deluxe room. (B).

The 12,016-hectare Arenal Volcano National Park lies within the 204,000-hectare Arenal Conservation Area, protecting eight of Costa Rica's 12 life zones and 16 protected reserves in the region between the Guanacaste and Tilarán mountain ranges, and including Arenal Lake. Arenal Volcano has been constantly active since it woke up after 400 years. One of the world's most active volcanoes, Arenal produces huge ash columns, explosions and glowing red lava almost every day. Fascinating fauna and flora exist here in amazing quantities making this a prime location for viewing many different species of plants and animals. Among the principal fauna species are: pacas, deers, tapir, coatis, sloths, howler monkeys, white-faced monkeys, snakes and birds like quetzal, bellbird, and hummingbird. There are also over 850 identified birds that reside in the Arenal area.

Day 4, ARENAL

Free day at Arenal. Arenal Nayara Hotel. (B)

Day 5, ARENAL – TAMARINDO

Transfer to Tamarindo (4.4 hours). Tamarindo Diria. Sunset Ocean View room (B) Tamarindo Beach and Bay is part of Cabo Velas Cape. Playa Grande lies to the north of Tamarindo Beach inside the bay. The two beaches are separated by a natural salt water estuary, the Tamarindo mangroves. South of Tamarindo Bay there is another beautiful estuary and beach, Playa Langosta. Both Playa Grande and Playa Langosta are protected areas for the giant leatherback turtle, and part of Costa Rican National Park system. These beaches are a major worldwide nesting area for sea turtles - the nesting season is from October to March.

Optional tours led by official guides are available to take visitors to see this incredible spectacle. Another very special optional tour is the jungle boat ride. Small groups are ferried on locally built skiffs deep into the mysterious mangrove forest, where a breathtaking diversity of birds, mammals, and reptiles can be seen.

Days 6 & 7, TAMARINDO

Free day at Tamarindo. Tamarindo Diria. (B)

Day 8, TAMARINDO – MONTEVERDE

Transfer to Monteverde (3 hours). Fonda Vela Hotel. Junior Suite. (B)

The spectacular Monteverde Cloud Forest Biological Reserve is a very important and popular ecotourism destination in Costa Rica. With its unique cloud canopy, this biological reserve located in Puntarenas province is 6 km east of the town of Santa Elena. Monteverde Cloud Forest Biological Reserve is one of the most stunning and breathtaking nature reserves in the entire world. Unlike rainforests, cloud forests usually receive much less rain in comparison. However, because a cloud forest is situated at a higher altitude, it has more humidity and is

therefore cloudier than a rainforest. This biological reserve sits at an elevation of between 1,200 m to 1,600 m, and is surrounded by a misty cover that supports a fantastic diversity of flora and fauna. Often creating a surreal environment, this reserve is considered to be among the most exceptional wildlife sanctuaries in the New World Tropics.

Day 9, MONTEVERDE

Free day at Monteverde. Fonda Vela Hotel. (B)

Day 10, MONTEVERDE – MANUEL ANTONIO

Transfer to Manuel Antonio (4.2 hours). Arenas del Mar Hotel. Ocean Breeze Superior room (B)

Manuel Antonio on the Pacific Coast, with an estuary, mangroves, a lagoon, beaches and winding paths, is on 638 hectares of land and 55.000 hectares of protected marine environment. Take a walk through the tropical forest and find mosses, ferns, flowers and epiphytes growing thickly on every tree. Throughout the park, you will find the famous wildlife Costa Rica is known for - monkeys, sloths and lots of birds among others.

Days 11 & 12, MANUEL ANTONIO

Free days at Manuel Antonio. Arenas del Mar Hotel. (B)

Day 13, MANUEL ANTONIO – SAN JOSE

Transfer to San José (3.5 hours). Hotel Finca Rosa Blanca. Cafetal room. (B)
